## STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

Accommodations will be made for students with disabilities, so long as the student is able to perform the duties required of a vocational nurse.

In accordance with Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act and Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) as amended, Career Development Institute, Inc. abides by the regulation that “no otherwise handicapped individual” shall be excluded from participation in the programs and services offered by the School “solely by reason of the handicap.” A student is eligible for consideration for accommodations and/or auxiliary aids and services if the student has a disability and the Director of Nursing and/or Assistant Director of Nursing has met with the student, and determined that the functional limitations of the disability require accommodation, auxiliary aids, and/or services.
